Event Description:

Bioengineering day is a yearly celebration of student research in the Bioengineering Department of UC San Diego, bringing together students, faculty, alumni, friends, and industry partners. Featuring a combined undergraduate and graduate poster session, as well as a series of talks given by select graduate researchers, BE Day is a distillation of the most advanced and impressive research here at UCSD Bioengineering. The invited keynote speaker and panalists expose attendees to opportunities and advancements in academia and industry. While focused on Bioengineering, the event is open to all departments. The program starts with a keynote speaker and this year we are excited to J. Craig Venter as our speaker in the morning. Afterwards, both undergraduate and graduate students present their poster, which will be displayed in the lobby of the Sanford Consortium. Alumni and industry members serve as poster judges. After lunch, selected graduate student researchers give brief oral presentations. A panel talk from invited guests follows the research talks; this year, on the team of "Inspiring the Next Era of Innovation". A networking reception provides an opportunity for students to meet and interact with the speakers and industry guests. Meanwhile, undergraduate student teams battle in a QuizBowl competition of Bioengineering Knowledge. Finally, awards are presented for the top graduate poster, undergraduate poster, and graduate research talk.
